MEXICAN CORNBREAD

1 1/2 c. self-rising cornmeal
1 green pepper, cut up
3 eggs
1/2 c. oil
1 can cream-style corn
1/2 tsp. ground black pepper
1 pkg. grated cheddar cheese
1/2 c. buttermilk

Mix all the ingredients and put in 9 x 13-inch pan. Bake at 350 degrees for one hour.
